

# COVID-19 Visitor Advisory

As part of our heightened surveillance against COVID-19 and to reduce the risk of infection, please note the following changes to our visitor policy:



Only **1 visitor/companion per patient (including caregiver)** is allowed in all clinical care areas at any one time.



**Refrain from bringing young children** to all clinical care areas, for their own safety.



All patients & visitors/companions **must bring their own masks** and ensure that the mask is worn at all times. **Masks will not be provided.**



**All visitors** must undergo **temperature screening.**

**You must inform our staff if you:**



Are serving a Stay-Home Notice



Had close contact with someone with COVID-19



Have fever (>37.5°C), breathlessness, body ache, headache, cough, chills, fatigue, sore throat or runny nose

The information you provide is important in managing the risk of COVID-19 transmission. The Infectious Diseases Act requires a person who has reason to suspect that he is a case or carrier of COVID-19, or has had contact with a person with COVID-19, to act in a responsible manner to not expose other persons to the risk of infection by the disease.
